

What is the CORE TEAM & ADULT VOLUNTEER ROLES?

CORE by Definition:

Everyone has a baptismal call to serve. A CORE Member is an adult who is responding to his or her baptismal call to serve in youth. SJB LIFE TEEN Youth ministry is rooted in service, commitment, and dedication to the Church and to the teens you serve.

1. CORE TEAM MEMBERS

Facilitate the religious, spiritual, educational, emotional, and social development program goals of the **SJB Life Teen**.

- CORE Members are role models to all of our teens. We know that how you live and act makes a strong impression of teens.
- The CORE Members work under the supervision of the SJB Youth Ministry staff for the purpose of assisting in the fulfillment of the SJB LIFE TEEN program.
- Core Members are vital to the planning, preparation, and execution of **Life Nights**, Retreats, and other activities.
- *This is a commitment from September thru July.*
- *Virtus Training required*



2. CAP (Constant Adult Presence)

The routine presence of Adults at weekly and special or seasonal activities assists in the overall mentoring process for Youth. **CAP** seeks to unite the mature witness of Adults from the SJB faith community with teens by *life-giving, supervision and chaperoning encounters.*



3. LIFE SUPPORT MEMBERS

Provide time and service to *support* & carry-out specific tasks -- kitchen crew, ushering, welcoming, assisting teens in projects -- and they may donate food, supplies or time to help at an event. *This status is **ON-CALL or as needed.***
